

Operations Odyssey Dawn (ODD) & Unified Protector (OUP)

Creating a logistics and supply chain for the US Navy

Situation

Starting in 2011, the US Military joined the international military operation in Libya to enforce the United Nations Security Council's Resolution. The US Military required a heavy increase in normal stock levels to support the Navy's escalated movement in the Mediterranean.

Solution

Tapping into our network of mobilization centers around the world, we established a supply chain from CONUS to Italy. From there, we supplied US Navy vessels and significantly increased normal stock levels to supply critical support for mission personnel.

Result

We completed 15 airlifts from CONUS to Italy, which resulted in a massive increase in stock over normal levels and allowed for uninterrupted operations as the US Military strengthened its presence in the Mediterranean.
